

Chicken or Egg Hypothesis

Which came first, the chicken or the egg? The answer is the egg. According to our understanding of biological evolution, reptiles or reptile-like dinosaurs evolved into bird, and both lay eggs. A birdlike (chicken-like) reptile laid an egg, which was mutated. When it hatched, out popped the first bird (chicken). Therefore the egg preceded the chicken. The fossil record verifies this.
